Holiday Club

During the holidays we give out school over to Smart Body Sports group. Who offer holiday activities for the children (outdoor and quieter indoor activities too). The children who have attended have been very positive about their experience. They will be running the club this Easter from 7th to the 11th April from 9:30am to 2:30pm. If you are in receipt of free school meals it is completely free, if not it is £15 per day. You can choose as many days as you like. Please call into the office if you cannot find your email telling you how to book on.

School meals

As you are aware school meals can be booked in advance via the Evolve system. The orders 'speak' directly to the school kitchen. We have noticed that on a Monday in particular there are some children who are receiving the default meal (cheese sandwiches) instead of a meal of their choice, as their meal has not been ordered from home. This can cause some upset. We ask that you please book the meals in advance, so the children are offered something that they'd like to eat. (You can book them as far as Easter right now.)
