

Behaviour Policy 2020 Covid-19 Addendum

At Bryn St Peter's CE Primary School, we aim to maintain a secure, caring and stimulating environment in which children are encouraged to have respect for themselves and each other.

Whilst expectations in our Behaviour Management Policy remain pertinent, it is necessary, in light of the Covid-19 pandemic, to make some adjustments for the safety of all pupils and staff.

- Families must follow the altered routines for arrival or departure. (see website for most up to date arrangements)
- Children will be directed to follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising.
- Children will be asked to socialise and work in their own bubbles and be expected to respect this. Each class will use a dedicated entrance/exit.
- Catch it, bin it kill will be an expectation for all
- Children will tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus or are unwell and parents will be contacted.
- Equipment, where possible, will not be shared.
- Purposeful coughing or spitting towards others will not be tolerated and may lead to formal exclusion.
- Rewards and sanction systems remain the same
- It is important that parents/ carers support the school and help their children to learn the necessary safety precautions such as, hand washing etc.

The simple poster below is designed to remind the children of the changes.

Follow the Covid Code!

Do 😊	Don't ☹️
Stick with your bubble	Don't mix with other people who are not in your bubble
Make sure you come in and go out from the same door each day.	Don't come early to play in the playground with people who are not in your bubble
Wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds	Don't touch your face if you can help it
Cough or sneeze into a tissue, bin it and wash your hands	Don't cough or spit at anyone else
Stay in the area of school or the playground that your adult tells you that you can go in	Don't leave the classroom without an adult
Tell an adult if you don't feel well	Don't come to school if you are ill
Try hard not to touch anyone else	Don't share things without checking with an adult.
